Swiss Nanotechnology PhD Award

The Swiss Micro- and Nanotechnology Network is offering **five prizes** each of 2'000 CHF for **excellent scientific first-author publications** in the field of **Nanotechnology** and **Nanoscience** published by **PhD students** in 2016/2017 sponsored by:



The prizes will be awarded at the annual Swiss Nanoconvention conference, *i.e.* 1-2 June 2017, in Fribourg: (<http://swissnanoconvention.ch/2017/>)

Requirements:

As a rule, the work should come from a Swiss university or research institute, and should not be older than 2 years. The manuscript can be written in German, French or English and must be either accepted for publication in a peer-reviewed journal or published in a peer-reviewed journal not longer than one year before the submission deadline.

The application must include:

- 1) A nomination letter by the PhD advisor
- 2) A curriculum vitae including a list of activities and publications
- 3) A short summary stating the importance of the work (max ½ page)
- 4) A copy of the manuscript of the published work
